# Higher Deposit Rates Are Here!

Say hello to higher rates! Effective June 1, 2022, we raised rates on regular share certificates and Zia Checking.

The Federal Reserve (the central banking system of the United States) raised the benchmark interest rates in May 2022, and as a result, we've followed suite. However, if you have money elsewhere, don't expect to see increases across the board. In fact, it's estimated most banks won't raise rates anytime soon. "The biggest banks in particular are sitting on a mountain of deposits. The last thing in the world they're going to do is raise what they're paying on those deposits," said Greg McBride, Chief Financial Analyst at Bankrate.com. That's where your credit union comes in.
