"Having a location in Rio Rancho is key to our ongoing 'People helping people' mission," remarked Rio Grande Credit Union President/CEO Chris Fitzgerald. "Our membership has been asking for a Rio Rancho location for awhile now. And since the members run our credit union, this became a pretty straightforward decision."

Board Chair Lucy Sedillo said, "Bringing one of Albuquerque's legacy credit unions to the City of Vision just makes good sense for our members and future growth of their families and our community."

Rio Rancho Mayor Greg Hull added, "Having Rio Grande Credit Union here to establish roots in the Unser gateway is an excellent addition to the live, work, play environment in Rio Rancho. We're pleased they've chosen to invest in our community."

The Cabezon branch is located at the intersection of Cabezon and Unser. It's scheduled to open in September this year. It will be the 6th branch of Rio Grande Credit Union.
